# Cooked Meals

**Providing free meals to the under privileged people.**

**The meal provided is a simple 2 item menu like Rice with Daal or Khichdi with Subji**

## **Cost**

**Serving a hot cooked meal per person-  
Rs. 20/-  
Cost of Family Pack of dry ration for 21 days : Rs. 750/-**

## **Duration**

**1 week/ 1 month/3 months**

**Location – Jaipur, Ajmer and Rajasthan for Cooked Meals**

**Dry Ration – Pan India**

# Medical Equipment Donation

Ensuring access to medical equipment to COVID-19 testing centres and civil hospitals.

Support Government of Maharashtra for its civil hospitals with ventilators, monitors, thermal scanners, infusion pumps, patient stretcher trolleys and more

INR 15,00 – 5,00,000  
Additional Cost - 10%  
Admin cost of NGO on ground

# Livelihood Intervention

10,000 families

# Direct Cash Transfer to Vulnerable Households and Frontline Health Workers

Direct Cash transfer to 50,000 highly vulnerable households led by women and dependent on daily wages and Frontline Health Workers

Loss of jobs and livelihoods to affect massively, especially the vulnerable communities

**Duration-**  
Two instalments over a 1-month period

**Location –**  
Bihar, Delhi, Maharashtra, Jharkhand, Odisha, Rajasthan, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand
