



Overview of Exports in UP




Uttar Pradesh aspires for doubling the exports, thereby contributing significantly to India's \$2 Tn Export target by 2030

Exports from Uttar Pradesh has doubled and entered new markets






Overall Export Growth






Total Value of Exports (In INR Cr)

Product Diversification

UP expanded its product portfolio by 6.4%, adding 240 new products, with 3,961 unique products in FY 2024 compared to 3,721 in FY 2019.

Initiatives taken to Boost Exports in UP (1/3)

Critical success factors: Institutional Framework





Institutional Framework

Export Promotion Bureau (EPB), UP

- Exclusive wing of the State to promote exports
- Headed by Export Commissioner (Principal Secretary, MSME & Export Promotion Dept)
- Facilitates exporters in managing export procedures
- Coordinates with central and State Government departments to ensure facilities and assistance offered by them
- Oversees the state's overall export activities
- Interaction with trade bodies, export promotion councils, DGFT, Ministry of External Affairs

Uttar Pradesh Export Promotion Council

- ► The first ever state level Uttar Pradesh Export Promotion Council
- A non-profit, Section 8 company under the Companies Act, 2013 incorporated in 2016
- Formation of 15 Panel Committees for product groups: Agriculture and Meat, IT C Electronics, Pharmaceuticals, Handicraft, Handlooms and others
- Give a thrust to a particular product / services
- Prepare strategy for growth of prominent sectors
- Organizes institutional participation in Domestic/ International Trade Fairs, buyer seller meet and exhibitions
- ▶ Regular interaction with exporters

District Export Promotion Committees

- Headed by District Magistrate in all 75 districts
- Conduct comprehensive analysis of the strength of each districts and the gaps in product quality/design, production efficiency, infrastructure, logistics etc.
- Map the existing trade infrastructure available for thrust sectors
- Identify major bottlenecks and challenges hindering exports of such sectors in the district
- Identify training and development needs of district industries
- Act as a grievance redressal forum for exports

Initiatives taken to Boost Exports in UP (2/3)

Critical success factors: Schemes and Subsidies

Financial Support

- Incentives under different schemes such as MDA (sending samples, quality certification, participation in trade fairs), Gateway Port, Air Freight rationalization
- · Interest Subvention on export loans
- Export Credit Guarantee: Partnered with banks to mitigate risk to exporters
- Reimbursement of SGST for certain EOUs

Export Infrastructure

- Trade Infrastructure for Export Scheme (TIES)
 - o Trade Promotion Centre, Lucknow
- oPackhouse and Processing Facility for Agri Products, Mirzapur
 - o Testing Lab and training center for packaging in Lucknow in collaboration with Indian Institute of Packaging
 - Niryat Awasthapana Vikas Yojana (NAVY): Dedicated Scheme of State to fill Export Infrastructure gaps
 - 4 CFCs including Leather Testing Lab and Design Studios, Agra, Glassware Designing and Packaging, Firozabad
 - CFCs under ODOP
 - \circ 27 CFCs including Testing Labs and Raw Material bank for Apparel & Textile, G.B. Nagar, Button Processing and Polishing unit, Sambhal etc



Market Access

- Institutional participation in National/ International Trade fairs such as AFL Artigiano, IESS, Autumn Fair etc through UPEPC
- Incentives for individual participations under MDA Scheme
- On-boarding of MSMEs on E-commerce platforms like Amazon
- UPITS UP International trade Fair and other sectoral trade fairs (Bhadohi carpets
- Organizing buyer-seller meets

Capacity Building Programs



- Tie up with Centre for WTO Studies, IIFT New Delhi to conduct workshops on Basics of Exporting for MSMEs, Export Marketing Strategies, Managing Logistics; Supply Chain for Exports, Foreign Trade Policy and Incentives, Incoterms etc.
- Export Conclaves in collaboration with FIEO

Geographical Indicators

- Export Promotion Bureau: nodal department for GI Registration
- GI board constituted under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, U.P.
- Total 77 GIs including 42 ODOP Products

Market Analytics

- Study of Export Eco-system of the State




