FICCI and National Book Trust signs MoU for the New Delhi World Book Fair 2013

NEW DELHI, January 23, 2013. The Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) has signed an MoU with the National Book Trust, Ministry of HRD to organise CEOSpeak over Chairman's Breakfast during the New Delhi World Book Fair 2013.
