FICCI celebrates National Sports Day and birth anniversary of Major Dhyan Chand

NEW DELHI, August 28, 2015. Every year FICCI celebrates National Sports Day, which falls on August 29, to mark the birth anniversary of hockey legend, 'The Wizard' Major Dhyan Chand, who is one of the most respected legendary figures in India and world hockey. He added that Australia and India were now working in tandem to promote sports as a profession.

Mr. Dilip Chenoy, MD and CEO, NSDC, said that parents should allow children to play sports as it would enable them to imbibe soft skills such as teamwork and communication. He added that the SSC would aggregate the efforts of the sports sector for employable workforce development by inviting participation, engagement and approval of the stakeholders.

In his theme address, **Dr. A. Didar Singh, Secretary General, FICCI,** said that officially signing a Sports Sector Skills Council grant agreement with NSDC would go a long way in promoting sports as a profession. Also, the Sports SSC would enable more opportunities to work in different segments within the sector like in sports medicine, sports manufacturing, sports event management, sports science and technology, and sports coaching.
