FICCI comments on India's joining the Missile Technology Control Regime

New Delhi, 27 June 2016: FICCI welcomes India's membership to the Missile Technology Control Regime (MTCR), one of the four multilateral export controls regimes that it is committed to enter as part of its international obligations.
