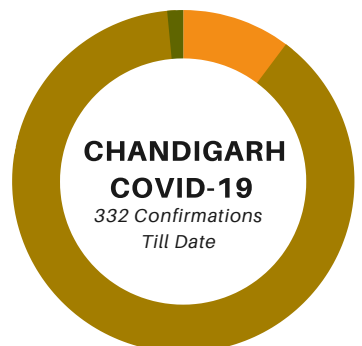
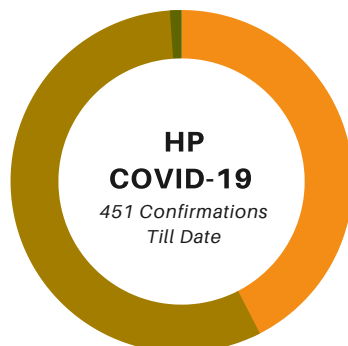

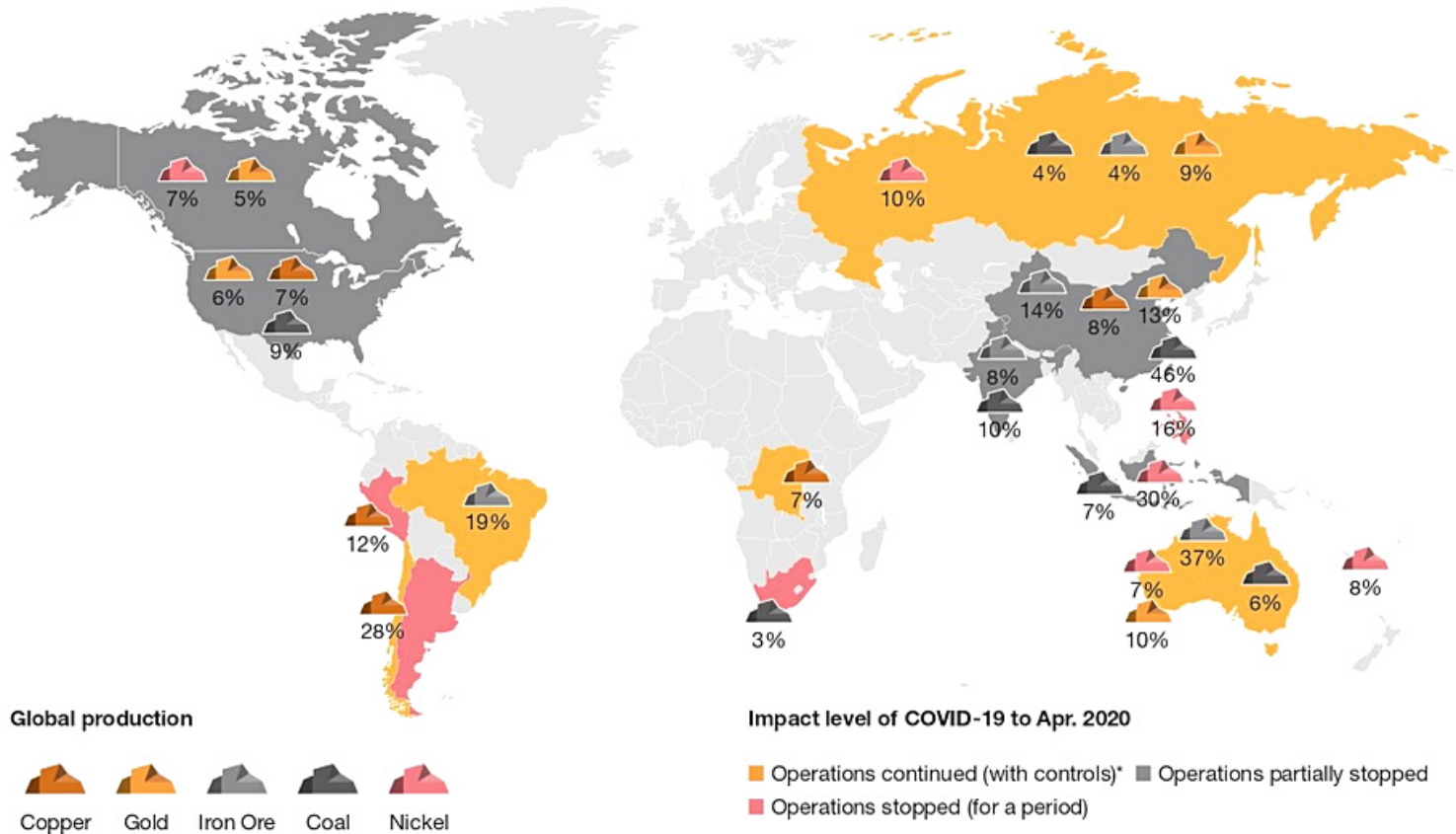

PwC in its recent release- *Mine 2020* forecasts a 6% hit to EBITDA (Earnings Before Interest, Taxes, Depreciation, and Amortization) for the Top 40 miners globally. Capital expenditure is expected also slow down in 2020, freeing up cash flows, and giving miners the capacity to pay dividends should they choose to do so. Increased economic uncertainty will hinder mega-deals for at least this financial year, but the same time, COVID-19 will present itself as an opportunity to capitalise on smaller acquisitions in their local markets. Overall, workplace and operational changes are in cards as the pandemic shall force the industry to rethink remote work and automation adoption.
