EDITORIAL

From The Secretary General



n the last few years, the perception of Uttar Pradesh (UP) has changed from a state with socio-economic challenges to an area of opportunity with growth and stability under the stewardship of Chief Minister Shri Yogi Adityanath. UP's progress over the last few years embodies the aspirations of over 20 crore fellow Indians living in our largest state.

FICCI held its National Executive Committee Meeting (NECM) in UP after a gap of 38 years.

This is a testament to the state's progressive and business-friendly regime focused on long-term growth and economic prosperity. In fact, acknowledging this return after four decades, the Chief Minister expressed his gratitude to FICCI for having the NECM in Lucknow. He also mentioned that the first business meeting that he attended after taking over as the Chief Minister in 2017 was also convened by FICCI.

UP has seen a robust economic trajectory in recent times. The state budget for 2023-24 has a robust blueprint towards a trillion-dollar economy, underscoring vigorous growth in Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) over the preceding year. UP has been the leader in expressway development by far. The most critical infrastructure for business is good law & order. Control of crime has been a priority of Shri Yogi Adityanath's government. The launch of 'Operation Conviction' and the significant dip in crime rates underscore the government's resolve towards fostering a safe and secure environment for trade and commerce.

For India to become the third largest economy in the world, our largest state, UP, would have to grow rapidly. As India's oldest and leading apex business chamber, I am confident that the transformation from Uttar Pradesh to Uttam Pradesh and eventually to Sarvottam Pradesh will be achieved in the near future.
