he recently concluded 10th Vibrant Guiarat Global Summit, a brainchild of Prime Minister Narendra Modi since its inception in 2003, has evolved from a state-level investment attraction initiative to a global forum for strategic partnerships and socio-economic collaborations. I have attended Vibrant Gujarat since 2005, and it is a pleasure to see the change over the last two decades both in the state and our country.
