Shyam Metalics commences Ramsarup ops.

State releases about Rs 32.50 crore for MSME&T projects.

Jupiter Wagons to raise 1000cr.

Jupiter Wagons will be raising up to INR 1,000 crore in one or more tranches through various routes amid a swelling order book and expanding business verticals. The fundraising could be through qualified institutional placement or other permissible modes such as public/private offering of equity shares or other convertible securities. The company has secured a contract from the ministry of railways for the supply of 2,237 wagons aggregating to 957 crore in March 2024 and an order of 697 wagons from the ministry of defence with a value of 473 crore. A new foundry is scheduled to be established in Jabalpur over the next 18 months for both captive use and exports which will increase the wagon manufacturing capacity of the company will increase from 900 wagons per month to 1,000 wagons per month.
