- India plans to spend \$1 Trillion on infrastructure in next five years
- Indian airports require investments worth \$13 billion (Rs 65,600cr) in next five years; private sector to contribute \$10 billion (Rs 50,000cr)
- Highways sector will attract investments worth \$123 billion in next 5 years
- \$300 billion planned to be spent on upgrading rail infrastructure (including new rail lines, double/multiple lines, high-speed rail) by 2020
- Around \$55 billion (Rs 2,77,000cr) worth investments planned in major and non-major ports by 2020
