
# **Overview**

With nearly a 1.2 billion population, India requires a robust, modernized agriculture sector to ensure food security for its population. Scope for further increasing cultivable land is limited. In order to meet the food grain requirements of the nation, the agricultural productivity and its growth needs to be sustained and further improved. The same needs to be undertaken in a sustainable manner balancing the economic needs with environmental aspects. The purpose of this seminar is to discuss and highlight the developments in safer, green agrochemicals and their applications and their, judicious usage so that all the stake holders including the Indian Agrochemical Industry and the farmers become aware of the same. There is huge unrealized potential of growth of this sector, looking at presently very low consumption compared to the global levels.
