


Thiru. Vikram Kapur I.A.S., Principal Secretary, Industries Department, Government of Tamil Nadu who was the Guest of Honor in his keynote address said the Tamil Nadu Government plans to aggregate large areas of land through a 'land pooling model' to allow owners join hands with the Government to develop land for industrial use. He said the state government plans to create a land bank of nearly 54,000 acres of developed industrial lands. We have almost reached the half-way mark and the rest of it is in various stages of acquisition. Under the



new Land acquisition act, there are certain difficulties, including providing higher compensation to owners. He also said out of the 98 MoUs with a committed investment of Rs.2.42 lakh crore by industries signed at the Global Investors Meet in 2015, 62 projects are at various stages of implementation.

Thiru. K. Pandiarajan, Hon'ble Minister for School Education, Archaeology, Youth Welfare and Sports Development Department, Government of Tamil Nadu who was the Chief Guest at the meeting said that the State government was taking all steps to promote entrepreneurship in this state. He said that the State government is doing everything to ensure that a favorable climate prevails in the state for doing business. He praised the members of FICCI for bringing out valuable suggestions related to GST which he was able to table it in his discussion at the center.
