

3rd India-Taiwan Industrial Collaboration Summit 2019

FICCI in association with Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeiTY) coordinated the participation of Indian delegation in TAITRONICS 2019. TAITRONICS is Asia's leading electrical and electronic exhibition. The show was scheduled for **16-18 October 2019** in **Taipei, Taiwan**.

On the sidelines of TAITRONICS, FICCI also collaborated with Chinese National Federation of Industries (CNFI) & Institute for Information Industry (III) for the 3rd edition of **India-Taiwan Industrial Collaboration Summit 2019**. The summit had sessions on Electronic Manufacturing, Smart City, Green Technologies and Smart Automotive Components.
