### **1 Details for Submission of Nomination Form for Awards**

- We appreciate receiving all the entries through emails only.

## 2 Entry Fee

### Applicability & Amount

- Government:** There is NO entry fee for users from government departments to submit nominations.
- Private Sector:** There is a non-refundable fee of Rs. 5,000/- + 18% GST i.e., **Rs. 5,900/-** towards processing and handling charges, for each nomination form.
- PSUs and non-government organisations:** There is a non-refundable fee of Rs. 5,000/- + 18% GST i.e., **Rs. 5,900/-** towards processing and handling charges, for each nomination form.

### Mode of Payment & Mechanism

- Payment to be made through Cheque / Demand Draft drawn in favour of “FICCI”, Payable at New Delhi.
- Kindly mail us transaction details of payments made through NEFT/RTGS.
- Any submission without entry fee (wherever applicable) will NOT be considered.

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## 3 Eligibility Criteria

- Initiatives/ projects should have been completed and validation of results/ deliverables must be communicated to FICCI along with a closure report. In case of ongoing/ multi-year projects it is desirable that project should have completed more than 50% of its prescribed tenure and also its outcomes/ achievements can be analysed with help of independent/ 3<sup>rd</sup> party assessment report.
- Award Nominations will be considered from India only.
- A project / initiative can be submitted in multiple categories. Separate forms should be filled for different categories.
- Irrespective of the project language, all submission and project information must be in English language.
- All segments of the entry form should be completed, and information should be given in a manner prescribed in ‘Entry Form’ and ‘Guidelines for Submission of Entries’.
- Please try to keep your response concise & precise to the heading & description of each segment given in the entry form. You may share further details or any additional information about your entry through enclosures.

## 4 Annexures or Supporting Documents

- Enclosures to be sent in MS WORD, PDF, Power Point or JPEG formats.
- Please provide a proper file name to all the enclosures and also flag respective areas in the entry form for which enclosures are given.
- Heavy files (more than 10 MB in size) can be shared through a downloadable link

**5 Jury**

- a. Each Award Category will be judged by a Panel of Jury members.
- b. At the time of submission of nominations for awards, the award category under which the submission is to be considered should be clearly indicated.
- c. The decision of the Jury is final and binding.
- d. Jury holds the right to contact any eligible nominee for their doubt/queries regarding the project.
- e. The Jury panel reserves the right to declare any entry 'Not eligible' if a nomination is either incomplete or does not meet the basic criteria or expectations.
- f. Jury may decide not to award any nomination in any particular category.
- g. The Jury may confer "Special Jury Award"
- h. The final results will be announced during the Awards Function, details of which will be shared in due course.

**6 Other Terms & Conditions**

- a. Any false information submitted about the initiative will immediately lead to permanent disqualification of the entry.
- b. Any nomination form received after the last date of registration will not be entertained.
- c. Incomplete / not filled registration form will be rejected.
- d. The entry will not be considered if any nominee fails to submit the entire details of the nomination forms till the last date of Nomination.
- e. Entry fee is neither refundable nor transferable.
- f. An organisation / its official by submitting nomination agrees that either it is the holder of intellectual property rights associated with the information given on the project / initiative / service vide entry form, or has taken approval from the legal rights holder. FICCI will not be responsible for any kind of IPR / Copyright violation during the process of evaluation of entries or reproducing the information through its publication.
- g. An organisation / its official by submitting nomination agrees that all necessary compliances were met during the mentioned project / initiative and operations were conducted within the relevant policy / regulatory framework for drones (UAS/RPAS) as prescribed by the Government of India and authorities at state.
- h. All materials received [PPTs, Videos, Screenshots, Photos etc.] will become FICCI property during the nomination and can be used by FICCI Secretariat to produce any document or compendium of best practices for wider circulation.
