

# 1. Current Status of Helicopter & Fixed Wing Services in Arunachal Pradesh Helicopter Services--

• 3 nos. Helicopters (2nos of MI-172 & 1 Bell-412) are being operated for Passenger Services under Helicopter Subsidy Scheme of MHA, GoI connecting 29 locations in 19 districts of the State and Guwahati & Dibrugarh Airport.

#### **Fixed Wing Flights**--

• ATR-72 flight service by Alliance Air on:

"Guwahati-Pasighat-Guwahati" Route -3 days (Wednesday, Friday & Sunday).

• ATR-72 flight service under RCS by Flybig on:

"Guwahati – Pasighat – Guwahati" Route (7 days a week),

"Guwahati-Tezu-Guwahati" & "Tezu-Imphal-Tezu" Routes(6 days a week) "Guwahati-Itanagar (Donyi Polo Airport)-Guwahati" Route (6 days a week)

However, services of Flybig has been irregular and stopped for last few days.

2	Accommodation for Security personnel at Donyi Polo Airport complex- Although State Police has been engaged temporarily for Security Services of Donyi Polo Airport until CISF takes over, the AAI has not yet made arrangements of accommodation in the airport complex for the Security personnel causing lots of inconvenience.	accommodation facilities urgently for the Security
