NO. 26 - CS/2020

Dated Kolkata, 25/03/2020

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, Government of India, under Disaster Management Act, 2005, has taken lockdown measures in the country. However, certain exceptions/exemptions have been notified under the said order. These read with exceptions/exemptions provided in the Complete Safety Restrictions as notified by Government of West Bengal include the following-

- 1. Law and Order, Courts and Correctional Services
- 2. Health Services and Veterinary Services
- 3. Police, Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces and Private Security Services
- 4. Electricity, Water and Conservancy services
- 5. Fire, Civil Defense and Emergency Services
- 6. Telecom, Internet, IT & ITES and postal services
- 7. National Informatics Centre, Early Warning Agencies
- 8. Banks, Insurance and ATMs
- 9. Food including groceries, vegetables, fruits, meat, fish, bread, milk, eggs, poultry feed, cattle feed storage and transportation
- 10. Cold storage and warehousing services
- 11. E-commerce of groceries, food items, and home delivery of food, pharmaceuticals and medical equipments
- 12. Public utilities including petroleum, CNG, LPG, PNG storage and transportation
- 13. Medicine shops, optical stores, pharmaceutical manufacturing and their transportation
- 14. Production and Manufacturing units requiring continuous process (after obtaining necessary approval from the District Magistrate in their respective districts and Commissioner KMC in Kolkata Municipal Corporation area).
- 15. Print, electronic media and social media, MSOs and Cable operators
- 16. Manufacturing units engaged in production of essential commodities
- 17. Hotels, home stays, lodges and motels, which are accommodating tourists and persons stranded due to lockdown, medical and emergency staff, air and sea crew.
- 18. Establishments used/earmarked for quarantine facilities
- 19. Movement of essential food commodities through road, airports, ports, railway sidings
- 20. Movement of forest sector essential services
- 21. Shops of seeds and pesticides

- 22. Manufacturing units for packaging materials of food items, drugs, pharmaceuticals and medical devices
- 23. Movement of patients and their attendants to and fro from hospitals and nursing homes.
- 24. People engaged in ongoing agriculture operations.
