The Govt. of Karnataka in its order referred at (2) above has exempted certain category of industries to carry on their manufacturing activities keeping in view the importance of maintaining supply chain of essential commodities during lock down.

Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, in its orders referred to at (3), (4) & (5) above, has exempted certain industrial establishments including production units, which require continuous process from the purview of the ongoing lockdown.

In view of the above, further to the existing list of essential industries cited at ref (2) above, the State Government hereby notifies <u>industries supplying to Defence & Aerospace manufacturing</u> exempting from the purview of the Lockdown and further to relax the restrictions imposed on the movement of workers and staff working in these industrial units.
