# Inflation needs to align with target by 2nd quarter: RBI monthly bulletin

India should sustain the strong growth momentum in the next financial year by securing at least a 7 per cent expansion in GDP while the headline inflation needs to align with the target of 4 per cent by the second quarter of FY25, as projected, said the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI's) state of the economy report issued on Thursday. The report said the "potential output is picking up with actual output running above it, although the gap is moderate," indicating there is no overheating in the economy.

# GDP growth will moderate to below 6% in December quarter: ICRA projection

Rating agency ICRA has projected the GDP growth rate to slow down to below 6 per cent in the December quarter, mainly account of sharp fall in kharif crop output, and weak progress in rabi sowing for some crops. India had registered a Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth rate of 7.6 per cent in the July to September period. The rating agency said the year-on-year growth in ICRA Business Activity Monitor eased for the second consecutive month to a six-month low of 8.1 per cent in December 2023 -- as against 7.9 per cent in December 2022 and 9.6 per cent in November 2023.

#### **Budget 2024: Modest tax revenue target likely for FY25**

The Centre is likely to budget a modest 9-11% increase in net tax revenue receipts in FY25 over the budget estimate for the current year in the February 1 interim budget. In absolute terms, the net tax revenue of the Centre is expected to be pegged at ₹25-26 lakh crore. In the current fiscal, the Centre has budgeted ₹23.3 lakh crore net tax revenue. The revised estimate for net tax revenue receipt in the current fiscal year, after devolution to states, will be at about the same level as the budget estimate, considering the likely shortfall in excise duty collections, people aware of the details told ET.

# Bharat brand of products: Franchise route for govt retail stores on the cards

The government is planning to use the franchise route to sell the Bharat brand of products to consumers directly, said a senior official. It will also employ mass media to create awareness about the initiative through which it offers subsidised kitchen essentials such as onion, pulses and atta directly to consumers. "We are looking at opening 50

stores across Delhi," the official said. The government is looking for someone to manage and operate the everyday operations of these stores, he added.

#### Govt may extend scope of PLI scheme to job-creating sectors: Deloitte

To incentivise the manufacturing sector and generate employment, the government may extend the scope of PLI scheme to include sectors like garments, jewellery and handicrafts in the forthcoming interim Budget, Deloitte said. Currently, Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme is available for 14 sectors. Deloitte India Partner Rajat Wahi said driving rural income is one of ways to deal with inflation and slack in consumption demand. "Today we have 14 sectors under PLI scheme, but a lot of these sectors do not generate massive employment. Leather, garment, handicraft, jewellery — many of these sectors need PLI scheme to come in because they are the ones which are the highest employment generators. ### Phone Sales: Strong festive demand saved phone sales in 2023, say market trackers

Robust demand in the festive season helped arrest a steep decline in smartphone shipments, with the market remaining almost flat in 2023, according to market trackers. According to research firm Canalys, mobile shipments fell 2% to 148.6 million units in 2023, though it marked a recovery from the sharp 6% decline in 2022. The market showed resilience, thanks to improved consumer confidence in the latter part of the year despite brands facing inventory challenges, inflationary worries and demand fluctuations during the year, Canalys added.

# India estimated to have harvested 355.35 MT horticulture crops in 2022-23

The country is estimated to have harvested 355.35 million tonnes of horticulture crops in the 2022-23 crop year, about 8.07 million tonnes more than the previous year, as per agriculture ministry data released on Thursday. The ministry has come out with the third production estimate after the harvesting of the 2022-23 horticulture crops. Agriculture Minister Arjun Munda said despite challenges surrounding climate change, horticulture production has gone up, thanks to efforts of farmers and agri-scientists.

# UP govt raises sugarcane prices by Rs 20 per quintal

The Uttar Pradesh government increased sugarcane prices by ₹20 per quintal on Thursday, a move that will benefit the influential voter bloc of sugarcane farmers in the state ahead of the general elections. While the 2023-24 crushing season started in October, the government has determined the state advisory price (SAP) only now, increasing the price of early maturing variety of sugarcane to 370 per quintal from 350, with the price of common varieties being increased to 360 per quintal and that of unsuitable varieties to 355 per quintal.

# Over 600 km of cycle tracks developed, 76,000 CCTV cameras installed in 100 smart cities: Centre

More than 600 kilometres of cycle tracks have been developed in 100 smart cities while over 76,000 CCTV surveillance cameras installed so far, the Union Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry said on Thursday. Under the Smart Cities Mission, 6,855 "smart classrooms" and 40 digital libraries have been developed. Also, over 50 lakh solar and LED streetlights have been installed and over 89,000 km of underground electricity cabling constructed, it said. The ministry said special purpose vehicles in these 100 cities are developing around 8,000 multi-sectoral projects worth more than Rs 1.7 lakh crore while 6,650 projects worth Rs 1.32 lakh crore have been completed till January 15 this year.

#### 12 Gw pumped storage hydropower projects get govt's green signal

The Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change (MoEFCC) has given the environment-related go-ahead to pumped storage hydropower projects with a capacity of 11.98 gigawatts (Gw). This marks the largest tranche of these new-tech energy storage projects to be approved in one go in the country. The clearance has been granted for eight projects, with an investment of Rs 81,981 crore, spread across five states, according to the notifications posted on the Parivesh portal of MoEFCC.

### UP raises state price for sugarcane by Rs 20 per quintal for 2023-24 season

With national elections round the corner, the Uttar Pradesh (UP) government has raised the state advised price (SAP) of all sugarcane varieties by Rs 20 per quintal for the 2023-24 (October 2023-September 2024) season to Rs 370 for early-sown varieties. However, farmers in western UP, who have been demanding a hike in SAP, don't seem to be too impressed, terming the hike as "inadequate."

### India to push for public stockholding of food grains at WTO MC13

India, in the 13th ministerial conference (MC13) of the World Trade Organisation (WTO) in February, will push for fast-tracking its demand for a solution on public stockholding for food grains, over negotiations on other agriculture-related issues. # Flows into NRI deposits double to \$7.3 bn in April-November 2023

The flow of money into Non-Resident Indians' (NRIs') deposits doubled to \$7.3 billion in April-November 2023 from \$3.63 billion in the same period a year ago. Inflows into Foreign Currency Non-Resident (FCNR) accounts increased to \$2.5 billion in April-November 2023 as against an outflow of \$199 billion in the same period of 2022, according to Reserve Bank of India (RBI) data The outstanding NRI deposits rose by \$1 billion to \$144.48 billion at the end of November 2023, up from \$143.48 billion in October 2023. They showed a marked increase from \$134.5 billion a year ago.
